THE GONDOLIERS.

ACT I. The Scene is laid in Venice

where contadine (flower-sellers) and gondoliers mingle in the crowd. The two gondoliers, Marco and Guiseppe, choose for their wives Gianetta and Tessa. The Duke and Duchess of Plaza-Toro, with their daughter, Casilda, and the attendant, Luiz, arrive. They are poor but proud Spanish grandees, who tell of their misfortunes. Casilda and Luiz are secretly in love. They have come to interview the Grand Inquisitor, to discover the young Prince of Barataria, who, when an infant, had been married by proxy to Casilda. The interview takes place, and the Grand Inquisitor tells them the child was hidden away from his father, and he is not sure which of the two gondoliers, Marco or Guiseppe, is the missing heir, the child having been given to a drunken gondolier who had an infant of the same age. The two gondoliers are now married, but are immediately taken from their wives and made to reign jointly, as one individual, until it is discovered "which is which."

ACT II. There are Revels in the Palace

the gondoliers' wives having joined their husbands. The Grand Inquisitor appears and explains the true situation. Then enter the Duke and Duchess, and the missing infant's old nurse, who has been sent for to identify him, arrives, and is able to settle the matter at once. She declares that she substituted her own baby for the Prince, so that neither Marco nor Giuseppe is the lost heir, but her own 'son,' who happens to be Luiz. Luiz and Casilda are at once united, and ascend the throne as King and Queen, while the gondoliers and their contadine thankfully leave the palace and state ceremony and go back to their old life.
